Students start this term with a new format of PSHRE lessons. Under the new name of Young leadership lessons are structured into six/seven lesson blocks in the form of themed projects. Student projects run alongside their taught lessons and will be completed outside of lessons to enrich students learning and skills by giving them opportunities to develop skills and independence over the areas employers, post 16 providers and Universities continue to feedback to us as areas students need to improve on including organisation, time management, oracy and independence. Year 7 and 8 have two project blocks per term as they have one lesson per week with their first deadlines just before half term on Oct 22nd. Year 9, 10 11 however have one lesson per fortnight and so their 7 lesson project spans longer over 10 plus weeks with a due date of 3rd of December.
