Dear Parents and Guardians,

Students start this term with a new format of PSHRE lessons. Under the new name of Young leadership lessons are structured into six/seven lesson blocks in the form of themed projects. Student projects run alongside their taught lessons and will be completed outside of lessons to enrich students learning and skills by giving them opportunities to develop skills and independence over the areas employers, post 16 providers and Universities continue to feedback to us as areas students need to improve on including organisation, time management, oracy and independence. Year 7 and 8 have two project blocks per term as they have one lesson per week with their first deadlines just before half term on **Oct 22nd**. Year 9, 10 11 however have one lesson per fortnight and so their 7 lesson project spans longer over 10 plus weeks with a due date of **3rd of December**.

Already we have welcomed a new cohort of year 7's who have taken to lessons and projects with great maturity and we look forward to developing their awareness and skills in the future. Year 11's begin their final act as we support them in what can be a challenging time of uncertainty as we explore their Post 16 options and students reflect and gather evidence of the skills and experiences that have come to form them in their lives this far. We encourage you to speak with your child about their Record of Achievement Project in support of their sixth form, college or apprenticeship applications and like all students you can ask your child invite you to their google classroom where you can see their assignments in full for the term. Until our next newsletter in the Spring please accept my thanks and best wishes for you and your families into the new year.
