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Developing Design Creativity and Innovation in Shanghai

Pete Maguire, Finham Park School

As a member of the Design and Technology Association has presented me with some amazing opportunities for personal and professional development. Since 2014, the Association has been providing advice and support to the Shanghai Ministry of Education (MoE), developing design, technology and engineering education in schools. Over the past two years, I have been involved in this work, receiving visitations in my own school and visiting schools myself in Shanghai.

Shanghai is amongst the highest ranking cities in the world's education league tables. However, Chinese educators acknowledge that their education system needs to become more inclusive, with less rote learning and more emphasis on applying knowledge to solve new problems in creative and innovative ways. The Shanghai MoE recognise the strategic gains of

incorporating design and technology into the Chinese education system and have invested a significant amount of funding in pilot schools. It has also established the Engineering and Technology Education Research Centre in the Minhang district of Shanghai and part of the ECNU (East China Normal University) Science Park. From here, they coordinate their teacher training and curriculum development, marking a commitment to developing implementing a design and technology curriculum.

The D&T Association has provided expert advice and consultancy, curriculum resources, a membership package for Chinese schools, hosted several MoE delegations and continues to run CPD course for teachers in Shanghai during the summer holidays.

As a Specialist Leader of Education (SLE), my involvement over the last couple of years has been to exemplify some of the outstanding D&T practice in the

- Finham Park provides over 70 OOHSL activities and experiences with 98% of pupils taking part in at least one.





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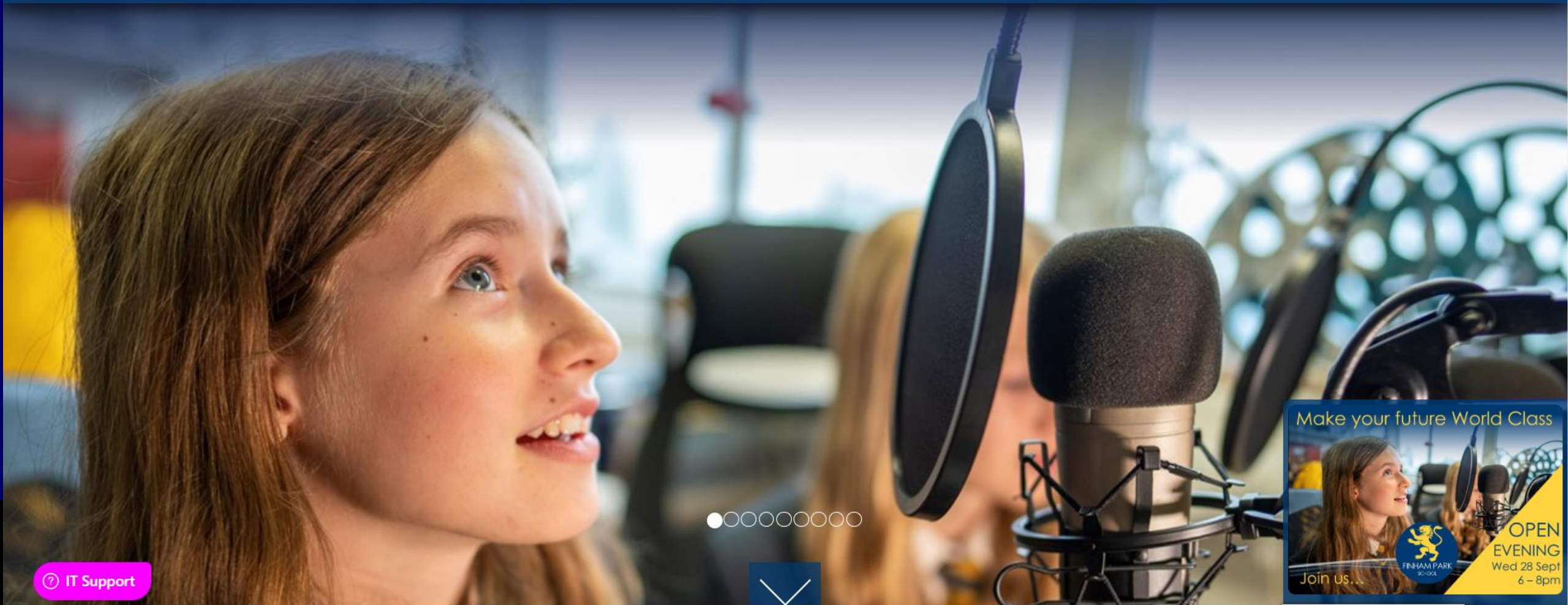
