WHO TO ADDRESS YOUR CONCERNS TO?

It is unlikely a concern a parent may have will need to be addressed to the Headteacher in the first instance. It is important your concern is raised to the right level as below as this will enable the school to address your concerns more quickly.

In cases where a concern does not reach the correct person, you will be referred to the right level as quickly as possible.

The Complaints Policy (found on the website) can be used if your concern has been unsatisfactorily resolved.
