

Maths revision techniques

Resources that have been made available to students for revision over Easter are:

- 10 for 10 revision packs- designed to be used for about 10 mins over ten days.
- Past papers.
- Exam practice books (white in appearance)
- Homework book with textbook on CD. If pupils return this book and CD they can exchange it for a tutorial CD called Maths Watch.
- My maths (www.mymaths.co.uk) is an online revision and homework tool.
 - In my maths there are booster packs designed for targeted revision. The homework section will generate new numbers every time it is accessed, so pupils can continuously practice. There is also a section for GCSE Statistics.
- Revision guides are on sale from the Finance Office:
 - Maths- £2.50
 - Statistics- £4.50

One of the best ways to revise maths is to practise it, and so the more questions that pupils can attempt the better. However, it is also essential that if pupils make mistakes that they find out how to do them correctly using any of the resources listed above.
