

### WHAT'S THE POINT OF THE MOCK EXAMS?


- They give you a chance to perform under realistic examination conditions and prepare you for the summer
- They help teachers make decisions about which ability level or tier to enter you for
- If the exams are cancelled, they will help teachers make decisions on estimated results (Centre Assessment Grades)
- They help teachers make judgments on where to target their teaching
- If you miss exams in the summer (eg ill-health), exam boards may use the results of Mock exams to award a grade.


### A COMPOSITE ROOMING TIMETABLE

### **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

- > DO THESE EXAMS COUNT TOWARDS OUR GCSE GRADES?
- > NO... BUT REMEMBER WHY YOU ARE DOING THEM THEY ARE STILL IMPORTANT!
- > DO I HAVE STUDY LEAVE? ...

NO – WHEN YOU FINISH AN EXAM YOU RETURN TO YOUR NORMAL LESSON; IF YOU DON'T HAVE AN EXAM YOU GO TO YOUR NORMAL LESSON

- > DO I NEED TO WEAR SCHOOL UNIFORM? YES (AND LAYER UP IF IT IS COLD)
- WHERE ARE MY EXAMS? SPORTS HALL (A12); ALTERNATIVE ROOMS: E BLOCK ROOMS (Upstairs) & the VENUE
- WHERE WILL I BE SITTING?
  SEATING PLANS FOR THE MAIN VENUES WILL BE POSTED OUTSIDE THE EXAMS OFFICE
  2 WEEKS BEFORE THE EXAMS START
- IF I HAVE AN EXAM AT 9.00 0R 9.15, DO I GO TO MENTOR PERIOD OR THE EXAM?
  GO TO YOUR MENTOR PERIOD FIRST YOUR MENTOR WILL DISMISS YOU FOR EXAMS AT EITHER 8.50
  OR 9.05; ALL AFTERNOON EXAMS START AT 1.15 PM AND YOU ARE ON LATE LUNCH EVERY DAY
- CAN I TAKE FOOD AND/OR DRINK TO MY DESK? NO FOOD; DRINK - ONLY WATER IN CLEAR BOTTLE
- > WHAT HAPPENS IF I AM ILL AND MISS ANY OF THE MOCK EXAMS?
- > IF YOU MISS MOCK EXAMS BECAUSE YOU ARE ILL, YOUR SUBJECT TEACHERS WILL EITHER ARRANGE FOR YOU TO DO YOUR EXAM IN ONE OF THE CATCH-UP SESSIONS OR DURING LESSONS

#### Appendix 5 Information for candidates for written examinations – effective from 1 September 2022

#### This document has been written to help you. Read it carefully and follow the instructions.

If there is anything you do not understand, especially which calculator you may use, ask your teacher.

#### A. Regulations - Make sure you understand the rules

- Be on time for all your exams. If you are late, your work might not be accepted.
- 2 Do not become involved in any unfair or dishonest practice during the exam.
- 3 If you try to cheat, or break the rules in any way, you could be disqualified from all your subjects.
- 4 You must not take into the exam room:

(a) notes;

(b) an iPod, a mobile phone, a MP3/4 player or similar device, or a watch.

Any pencil cases taken into the exam room **must** be see-through.

Remember: possession of unauthorised material is breaking the rules, even if you do not intend to use it, and you will be subject to penalty and possible disqualification.

- 5 If you have a watch, the invigilator will ask you to hand it to them.
- 6 Do not use correcting pens, fluid or tape, erasable pens, highlighters or gel pens in your answers.
- **7 Do not** talk to or try to communicate with, or disturb other candidates once the exam has started.
- 8 You must not write inappropriate, obscene or offensive material.
- **9** If you leave the exam room unaccompanied by an invigilator before the exam has finished, you **will not** be allowed to return.

10 Do not borrow anything from another candidate during the exam.

# **DURING THE EXAMS**

- MAKE SURE YOU ARRIVE IN GOOD TIME 10 MINUTES BEFORE THE START
- CHECK THE SEATING PLANS IN A BLOCK & ON THE DOOR FIND YOUR SEAT QUICKLY (YOU WILL BE SAT IN YOUR TEACHING GROUPS FOR THE MOCK EXAMS)
- > BRING THE RIGHT EQUIPMENT FOR YOUR EXAM (EG BLACK PENS, MATHS EQUIPMENT, ETC)
- > NO COMMUNICATION ALLOWED IN THE EXAM ROOM



#### TAKE MOBILE PHONES & WATCHES TO YOUR EXAM DESK. PHONES MUST BE TURNED OFF. PHONES AND WATCHES WILL BE COLLECTED AND GIVEN BACK AT THE END OF THE EXAM.



# AFTER THE EXAMS...

- > NORMAL LESSONS START AGAIN ON MONDAY 18<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER
- > ART EXAMS WILL TAKE PLACE BEFORE THE END OF TERM YOUR ART TEACHER WILL CONFIRM TIMES & ROOMS
- RESULTS WILL BE ISSUED ON A MOCK EXAM RESULTS DAY BEFORE THE END OF TERM (DATE & TIME TBC)
- > TO AVOID DISAPPONTMENT, DON'T ASK YOUR TEACHERS FOR RESULTS BEFORE THIS – THEY ARE SWORN TO SECRECY

### WHO TO ASK IN SCHOOL IF YOU NEED HELP:

- It is NORMAL to experience feelings of anxiety about exams. If you are worried or anxious about your exams, talk to your teachers, well-being staff, College Leaders and friends about coping strategies
